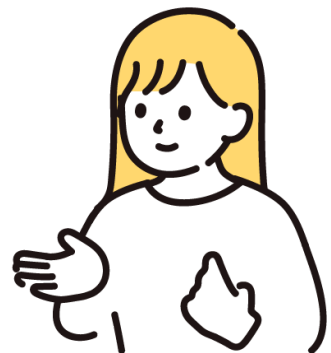

Elementary 1 class

Recommended for people who have studied a little Japanese before.

You will be able to communicate simply if the other person speaks slowly and clearly — for example, when talking about your town, notifying about absences or being late, expressing your thoughts after eating, or talking at a hospital.


Elementary 2 class

Recommended for people who can already have basic conversations in Japanese.

You will learn to exchange information in a variety of situations — talking about people around you, your country's food, annual events and manners, or listening to information about disasters and local services.
